

# Wireless Setup for Chromebook (eduroam)

## Note

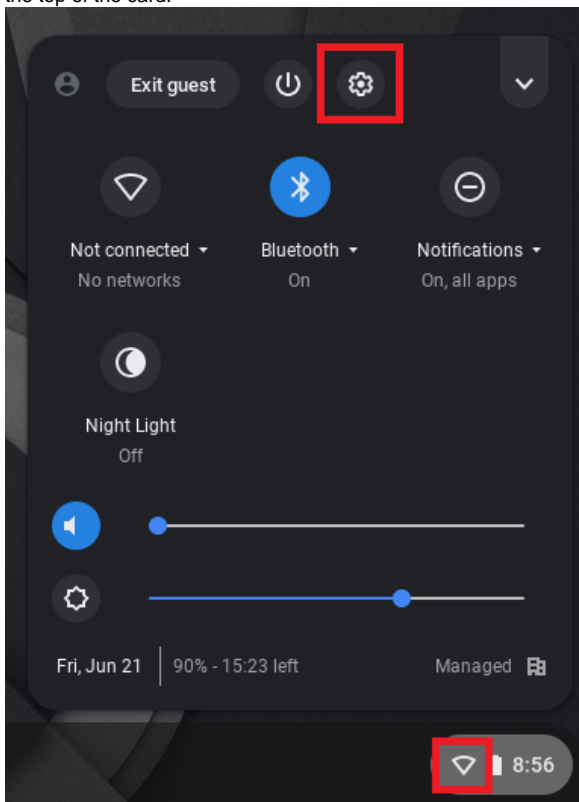
Joining the **eduroam** wireless network requires you to meet either one of the two conditions below...

- You have a UCCS username and password (because you are a student, faculty or staff) .... or ....
- You have an account through your institution, which is a participating institution with eduroam

If neither of the above apply to you, please visit the [UCCS-Guest](#) information page for information regarding guest wireless access.

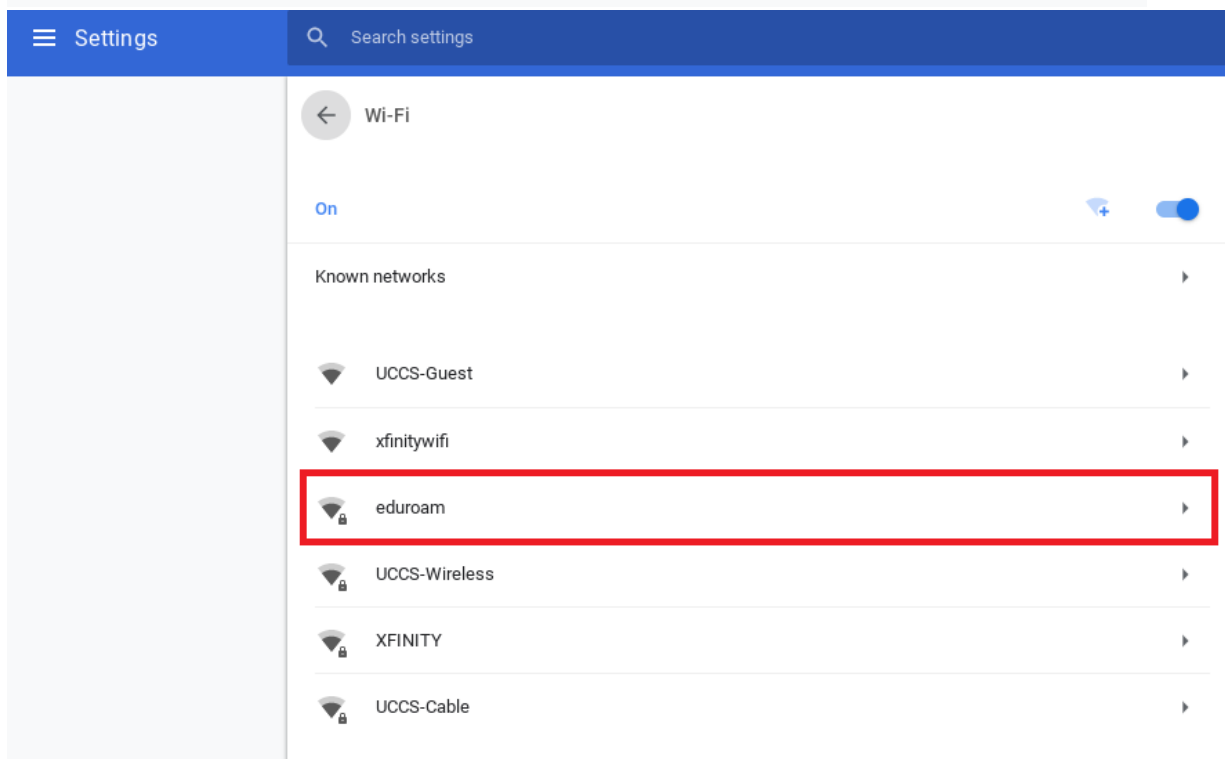
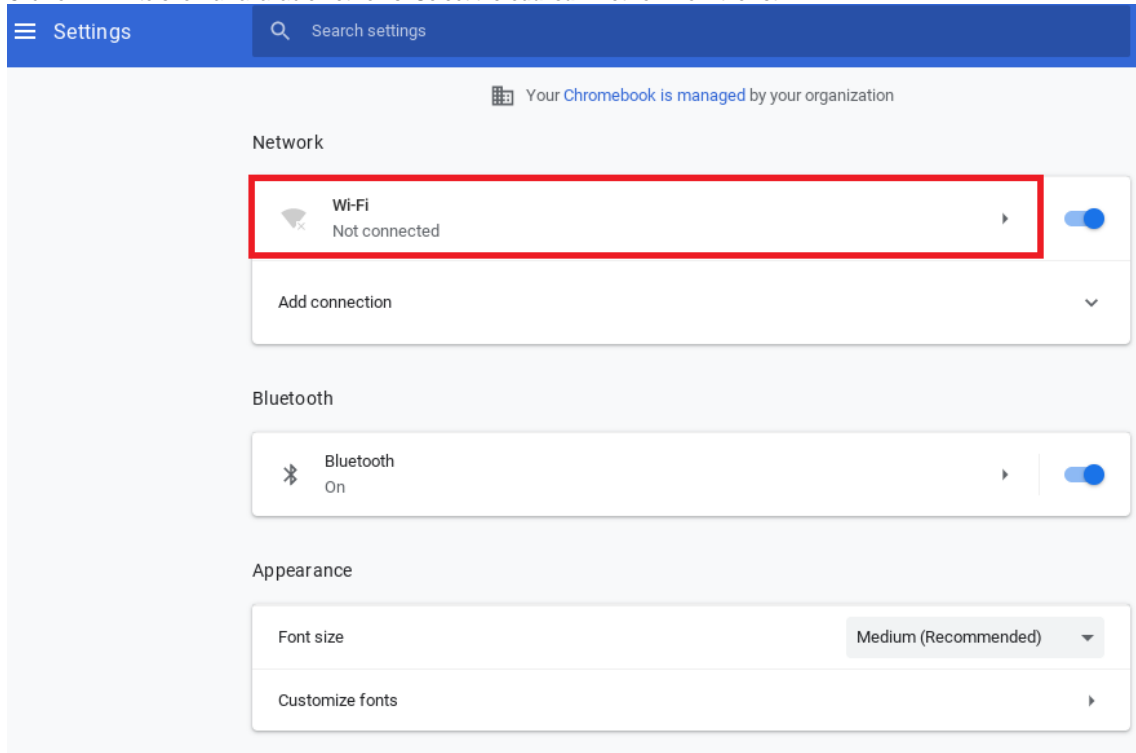
## Step 1: Open Network Settings

Click the **network** icon in the task bar, typically located in the lower right side of the screen. Then go to **network settings** by clicking on the gear icon at the top of the card.



## Step 2: Select the Eduroam Network

Click on **Wi-Fi** to show all available networks. Select the **eduroam** network from the list.



### Step 3: Choose Settings and Enter Your Username and Password

Make sure the settings match the ones listed below. Enter your UCCS username and password, then click **Connect**.

**SSID:** eduroam

**EAP method:** PEAP

**EAP Phase 2 authentication:** MSCHAPv2

**Server CA certificate:** Default

**Identity:** Enter your UCCS full domain username in the form **username@uccs.edu** (it must have "@uccs.edu" on the end)

**Password:** Your UCCS password

**Anonymous Identity:** <leave blank>

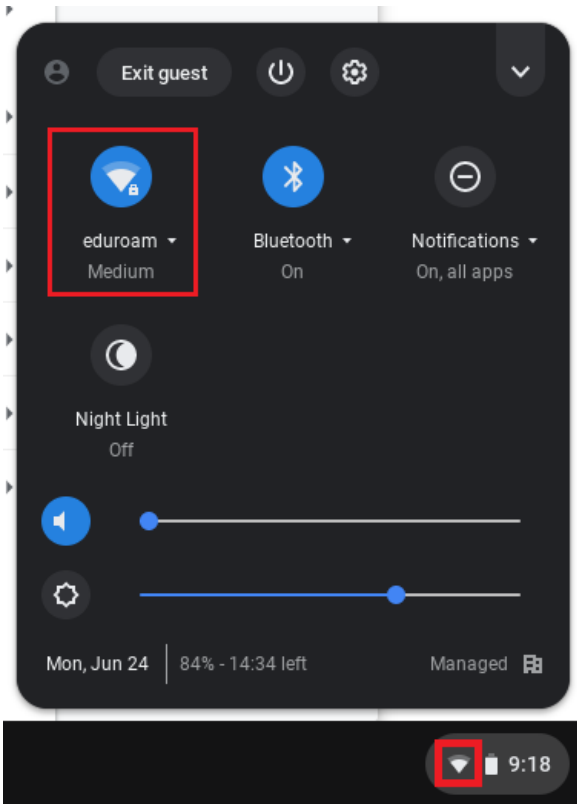

## Step 4: Verify Connection

Check to see if your device is connected by clicking the **network icon** located in the bottom right of the screen. The device should show that it's connected to *eduroam* and display the signal strength of the network.



Your device should now be connected to **eduroam**.
