

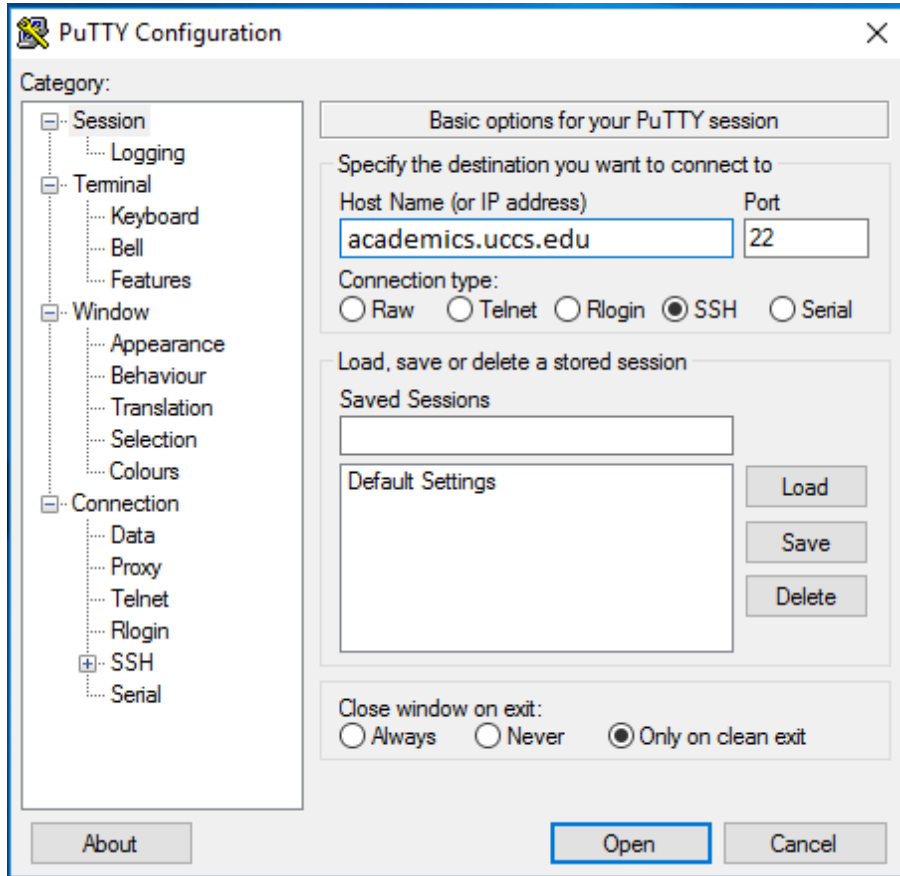
# PuTTY SSH Client Academics

You must be connected to the [VPN](#) to connect to the Academics Server from off campus

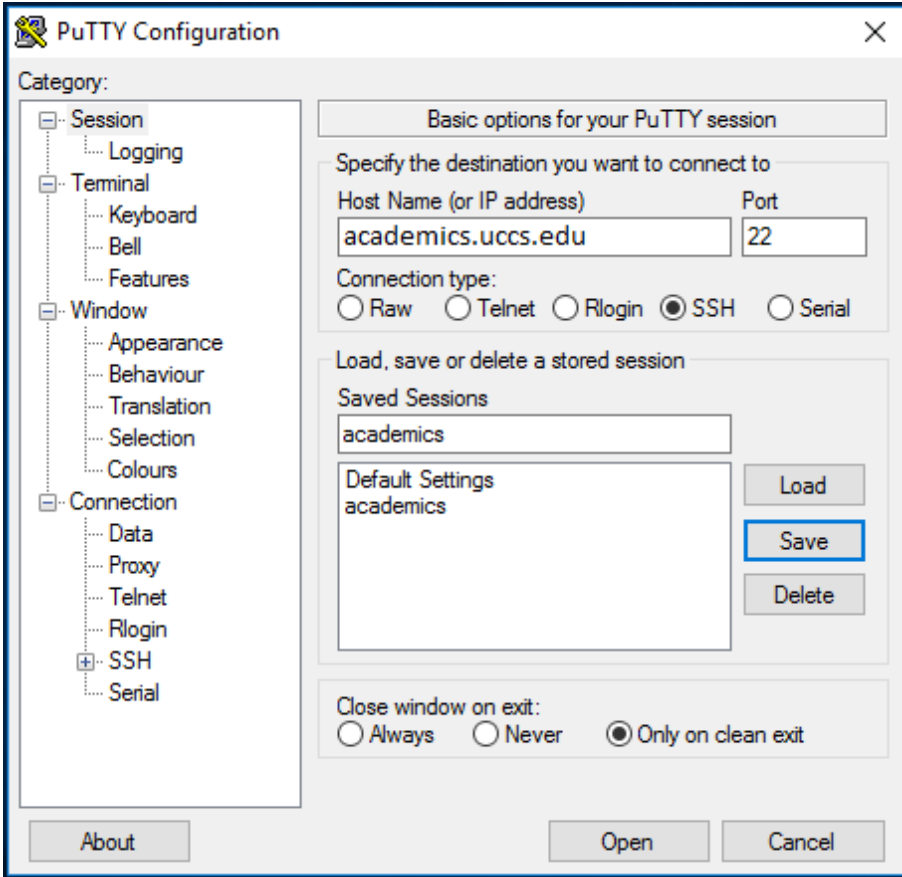
## Step 1: PuTTY Configuration

Fill Host Name (or IP Address) with **academics.uccs.edu**, Port with **22**, and Connection type as **SSH**.



## Step 2: Saving the Configuration

Under the **Save Sessions** section, give your configuration a name and then click **Save**. To use your saved session, click on it once to highlight and then click **Load**.



### Step 3: Opening the PuTTY Client once Configured

Once all of the settings are entered click **Open** at the bottom of the window. A black window will appear and you will be prompted to enter your UCCS username and password.
